## IX. Public Hearings

1. Ordinance #07-14 - Second Reading - Amending Chapter 30 of the Code of Ordinances to Delete Interest Charges on Special Assessment Nuisance Abatement Liens.

Mr. Langley read Ordinance #07-14 aloud by title. Council Member Dwyer moved to adopt Ordinance #07-14 on second and final reading. Vice Mayor Hunt seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.

2. Ordinance #08-14 – First Reading – Amending Chapter 2 of the Code of Ordinances to Authorize the Special Master and City Manager to Expedite the Lien Reduction Process.

Mr. Langley read Ordinance #08-14 aloud by title. Council Member Dwyer suggested that decisions made pursuant to subsection (j) of the proposed ordinance should not be subject to appeal pursuant to section 2-95 of the Code of Ordinances. Mr. Langley stated that it was a good suggestion. Vice Mayor Hunt moved to adopt Ordinance #08-14 on first reading, with the inclusion of verbiage suggested by Council Member Dwyer. Council Member Handy-Peters seconded the motion. The motion passed 4-1, with Council Member Dwyer dissenting.

3. Transmittal Hearing to Consider Ordinance #09-14 – Adopting Text Amendments to the Transportation Element of the City of DeBary Comprehensive Plan.

Mr. Langley read Ordinance #09-14 aloud by title. Vice Mayor Hunt moved to transmit the proposed amendments pursuant to Ordinance # 09-14 to the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO) and the Volusia Growth Management Commission (VGMC). Council Member Dwyer seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.

Council Member Vihlen moved that the Council authorizes Pegasus Engineering, LLC for continued on-going general stormwater engineering services, for a Not-To-Exceed amount of \$35,000. Council Member Dwyer seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

Council Member Handy-Peters moved to approve Task Order 2014-3 with CPH, Inc. in the amount of \$129,545. Council Member Dwyer seconded. The motion passed 4-0, with Council Member Vihlen abstaining.
