2. Rob Sullivan Community Park Irrigation Contract Approval with Sterling & Sod.

Councilmember Dwyer motioned to approve the Irrigation Contract with Sterling Silver & Sod, Inc. as presented for \$107,215.00. Councilmember Handy-Peters seconded the motion. The motion passed 5-0.

3. Rob Sullivan Community Park Laser Grading Contract Approval with TS&C Construction Services.

Councilmember Dwyer motioned to approve the Laser Grading Contract with TS&C Construction Services as presented for \$55,304.20. Councilmember Handy-Peters seconded the motion. The motion passed 5-0.

4. Rob Sullivan Turf Sprigging Contract Approval with T Mac & Associates.

Councilmember Dwyer motioned to approve the Turf Sprigging Contract with T.Mac Wilder & Associates as presented for \$18,000.00. Councilmember Handy-Peters seconded the motion. The motion passed 5-0.

5. Award of Bid to Ovation Construction for Small Scale Stormwater Construction Projects.

Councilmember Dwyer Motioned to Award the contract for construction of Bid No. 01-15, Small Scale Stormwater Improvement Project No. 2 to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, Ovation Construction, Inc. for the amount of \$789,390.37 with a contingency reserve in the amount of \$39,000.00. The summation of the bid amount \$789,390.37, and the contingency reserve \$39,000.00, establishes a total budget amount of \$828,390.37. Councilmember Handy-Peters seconded the motion. The motion passed 5-0.

6. Resolution #15-04 FY 2015 Budget Amendment.

Councilmember Dwyer motioned to Adopt Resolution #15-04. Councilmember Brady seconded the motion. The motion passed 5-0.

7. Resolution #15-05 Public Records Request Policy.

Councilmember Dwyer motioned to Adopt Resolution #15-05. Councilmember Handy-Peters seconded the motion. The motion passed 5-0.

8. Resolution #15-06 Banking Authorizations.

Councilmember Dwyer motioned to Adopt Resolution #15-06. Councilmember Handy-Peters seconded the motion. The motion passed 5-0.
