

Dictating the removal of city employees reporting to the City Manager

Sec. 4.04. - Prohibitions.

(a)

Neither the Council, nor any individual member of the Council, shall in any manner dictate the employment or removal of any employee other than the City Manager and City Attorney, but the Council may express its views and fully and freely discuss with the City Manager anything pertaining to the appointment or removal of such officers or employees.

No individual member of the Council shall give orders to any officer or employee of the City. Recommendations for improvements in the City government operations shall come through the City Manager, but each member of the Council shall be free to discuss or recommend improvements to the City Manager, and the Council is free to direct the City Manager to implement specific recommendations for improvement in City government operations.

Mayor Johnson posted on Twitter that both the City's TOD Director and the IT Director should be fired. Mayor Johnson has not expressed these views with the City Manager nor has he discussed firing the TOD Director and / or IT Director with the City Manager. This is in violation of City Charter Section 4.04 (a).
