

Please be advised of the amended procedures for the August 24th 2016
City Council Hearing

These procedures supersede the August 18, 2016 Memorandum on the
procedures for the August 24th 2016 City Council Hearing

To ensure that all of those members of the public that wish to attend the City Council hearing on Wednesday, August 24, 2016 commencing at 6 p.m. may do so and to ensure the safety and security of all involved, the following procedures for the hearing(s) will be used.

- To accommodate a potentially large crowd, both the City Council chambers and the adjacent Florence K. Little Hall will be open and available to the public, regardless of whether a person intends to speak, offer testimony or evidence or just observe.
- The City Council will hear testimony and take evidence in the Council Chambers.
- Members of the public wishing to speak or offer testimony or evidence, whether in the Council Chambers or in Florence K. Little Hall, will be afforded that opportunity.
- Consistent with resolution 15-21, Speakers are limited to three minutes each. Six minutes for groups.
- The hearing(s), both visually and by audio, will be live-streamed into Florence K. Little Hall and to the public at large.
- Those members of the public that choose to attend the hearings in Florence K. Little Hall and wish to speak or offer testimony or evidence will be assisted by City Staff.
- The media will be allowed into Florence K. Little Hall and City Hall.
- All persons will be subject to security screening prior to entry into the Council Chambers and Florence K. Little Hall.
- Decorum rules (resolution 15-21) will be observed.
