

RESOLUTION 16-28

A Resolution of the DeBary City Council recognizing the employees of the City's Hurricane Matthew Emergency Response Team for their extraordinary service to the residents and property owners of DeBary during and immediately following the storm,

WHEREAS, on October 6 and 7, 2016, Hurricane Matthew struck the city with hurricane force winds blocking roads with downed trees and power lines, causing substantial storm debris throughout the city that had to be removed from private property, city parks, city rights of ways, and requiring extraordinary diligence in the operations of the city's stormwater system, and

WHEREAS, the City's response required considerable overtime efforts of the response team with some employees working 24-hour shifts for as long as two weeks without a day off,
