X. Public Hearings

1. Ordinance #01-13 – First Reading – Amending the Beautification Matching Grant Program to Create a Supplemental Sign Grant Program.

Mr. Ardaman read Ordinance #01-13 aloud by title. Council Member Hunt moved to approve Ordinance #01-13 on first reading to implement a supplemental sign grant program. Council Member Handy-Peters seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.

XII. Old Business

1. Little League Agreement Renewal.

Council Member Koval moved to approve the Facilities Use Agreement between DeBary Little League and the City Of DeBary. Vice Mayor Carson seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.

2. Suggestion to Name the Splash Park for Former Mayor Don Smith (Added by Mayor Garcia).

Council Member Koval moved to name the Splash Park after Don Smith. Mayor Garcia seconded. The motion failed 2-3, with Council Member Hunt, Council Member Handy-Peters, and Vice Mayor Carson dissenting. There was consensus to discuss the naming of the park at the next workshop.

XIII. New Business

1. Resolution # 13-01 – Approval of the LAP Agreement with FDOT for the Highbanks Road Sidewalk Project.

Mr. Ardaman read Resolution #13-01 aloud by title. Vice Mayor Carson moved to approve Resolution #13-01 authorizing the City to execute the LAP agreement with FDOT for the funding and construction of the Highbanks Road sidewalk project. Council Member Koval seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.

2. Construction Engineering and Inspection Services by GAI Consultants, Inc. for the Naranja Road & 2nd Street Drainage Improvement Project.

Council Member Handy-Peters moved to approve GAI's proposal to provide CEI Services for the Naranja Road & 2nd Street Drainage Improvement Project in the amount of \$54,000.00. Council Member Koval seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.

3. Construction Engineering and Inspection Services by GAI Consultants, Inc. for the Naranja Road Sidewalk Project.

Council Member Hunt moved to approve a task order with GAI for CEI services for the Naranja Road Sidewalk project in the amount of \$26,556. Council Member Koval seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

- 4. Miscellaneous Construction Engineering and Inspection Services – Budget Adjustment No. 1 GAI Consultants, Inc.

Council Member Handy-Peters moved to approve Budget Adjustment No. 1 for Miscellaneous CEI Services by GAI Consultants, Inc. in the amount of \$15,000.00. Vice Mayor Carson seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

- 5. Offer of Donation of Vacant Land to the City.

Council Member Koval moved to reject the offer for the parcel at 20 Craycroft Avenue. Council Member Handy-Peters seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

- 6. Synthetic Drugs (Added by Mayor Garcia).

There was consensus to send a letter of support encouraging the State Legislature to continue passing laws to address the problem of synthetic drugs.

- 7. Plaque Donation for Former Mayor Don Smith (Added by Mayor Garcia).

There was consensus to donate funds of approximately \$150 for the plaque honoring Mayor Don Smith in Deltona Veteran’s Memorial Museum.

- 8. Texting While Driving (Added by Mayor Garcia).

There was consensus to send a letter encouraging the State Legislature to pursue the ban of keyboard texting while driving.
