

Residential Refuse & Recycling Program

Acceptable Items

Residential Bulk Waste

- Furniture
- Carpet (maximum 6'x10' rolled, maximum weight 60 pounds)
- Grills, lawn equipment, bicycles, tires, furnaces
- White Goods – Contact Waste Pro prior to regularly scheduled pick up day
 - Refrigerators, ranges, water heaters
 - Freezers, Washers, dryers



Yard Waste

- Leaves, grass, shrubbery cuttings – must be bagged or containerized
- Palm fronds (any length)
- Tree limbs – bundled or neatly stacked at curb – maximum 4 feet long, 6 inches in diameter per branch or 60 pounds

Recyclable Materials

- Glass, aluminum, bi-metal/steel & plastic containers
- Newspapers, magazines & phone books, paperboard & bags



Preparation & Disposal

- Bulk household, vegetative waste, and recyclable materials should be placed in separate receptacles less than 5 feet from the curb.

HAZARDOUS MATERIALS ARE NOT ACCEPTED

Collection Days

Recyclable items and household waste are collected once per week on Tuesday, Wednesday or Friday, depending on the residence location.

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Special Collection Service

In addition to regular solid and yard waste collection service, residents may purchase special pickup service from Waste Pro for oversize objects, construction materials, and excessive amounts of household refuse and yard waste.
