► HEADS UP..... WINTER RECREATION PROGRAM

Boys & Girls 1st-5th Grade

Program Dates: Thursday, December 27th thru Friday, January 4th 7:30 AM to 5:30 PM....Closed on January 1st.

TO ALL OWNERS OF MAN'S BEST FRIEND

Following are two excerpts from the DeBary Code of Ordinances:

Article II. Animal Control

"Section 10-50. Removal of Animal Wastes

(a) The owner of every animal shall be responsible for the removal of any excreta deposited by his or her animal on public walks, recreation areas or private property other than his or her own.

(b) Any person found in violation of this section is subject to the penalties prescribed in section 10-32.

"Section 10-32. Penalty. A violation of this article is a civil infraction, which carries a maximum civil penalty not to exceed \$500.00. If a person who has committed such a civil infraction does not contest a citation issued to him or her, the civil penalty shall be less than the maximum civil penalty."



PROTECT THE ENVIRONMENT OF OUR CITY

Use Garden and Law Chemicals wisely, following package directions and only use pesticides, herbicides and fertilizers when other methods fail. Do not apply if rain is in the forecast. **WHY?** Excessive fertilizers and chemicals will wash off the property and into surface and ground waters.

It is recommended that you review City Ordinance #04-09 for fertilizer regulations within the City. **WHY?** To be informed regarding City regulations related to the application of fertilizers to lawns and turfs, restrictions on fertilizers containing phosphorus and nitrogen, restrictions in rates of fertilizer application, etc.

Use Compost Grass, Leaves and Shrub Clippings as mulch to supplement fertilizers. Do not rake these materials into roadways or swales. **WHY?** Grass, leaves, and shrub clippings will decompose, returning nutrients to the soil so that you can use less fertilizer. If placed in roads or swales, yard debris will block drainage flows and end up in the nearest water bodies.

Shop wisely and buy products labeled biodegradable, non-toxic, non-phosphorus, or water soluble. **WHY?** These products readily decompose and will not pollute surface or ground waters.

Do not drain used motor oil into storm drains. Take used motor oil to service stations. **WHY?** Motor oil and antifreeze are toxic and add pollutants to surface waters if placed or washed into storm drains.

PRESCRIPTION DRUG USAGE IN DeBARY

PRESCRIPTION DISCOUNT CARD! The City of DeBary has a new program to offer savings on prescription drugs to residents with or without health insurance, a traditional benefits plan or have prescriptions that are not covered by insurance. The Prescription Discount Card is made available to residents by the City of DeBary in collaboration with the National League of Cities (NLC) and is made possible through the City's membership in NLC. The card is FREE to all DeBary residents, regardless of age, income or existing health insurance. By using this card you may save an average of 20% off the regular retail price of prescription drugs at participating pharmacies. **THIS IS NOT INSURANCE.**

Residents may obtain a card in the City of DeBary at City Hall, 16 Colomba Rd; Winn-Dixie Pharmacy, 2 N US Hwy 17/92; Walgreens, 15 N US Hwy 17/92 or, for more information, call toll free 1-888-620-1749. Discounts are only available at participating pharmacies. By using this card, participants agree to pay the entire prescription cost less any applicable discount. Savings may vary by drug and pharmacy.

IDENTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR VOTERS

Prior to voting, voters shall be required to present a photo and signature identification. Acceptable forms of photo identification include:

Florida Driver's License United States Passport Debit or Credit Card Military Identification

Student Identification Retirement Center ID Neighborhood Association ID Public Assistance ID

Florida ID Card issued by the Department of Highway Safety & Motor Vehicles

If the photo identification does not contain the voter's signature, an additional identification with the voter's signature shall be required. If the voter fails to furnish the required identification, he or she shall be allowed to vote a provisional ballot. When someone's eligibility to vote is in doubt, that person is entitled to a provisional ballot.
