TRAFFIC UPDATE – SHELL ROAD STORMWATER CONSTRUCTION PROJECT – July 23, 2010

Work on the Monroe Avenue, Catalina Drive Stormwater Improvement Project is making good progress along Shell Road. Weather permitting, the traffic detours are expected to be removed and Shell Road reopened to traffic by the week of August 16, 2010.

Currently, Shell Road is closed from Spring Vista Drive through Palmetto Drive. During the week of August 2, 2010, Shell Road is scheduled to reopen to traffic from Spring Vista Drive to Sanford Avenue. The cross streets: Sanford Avenue, Monroe Avenue, and Palmetto Drive will remain open at all times for access by residents and all essential services. Caution is advised when traveling through the construction zones.

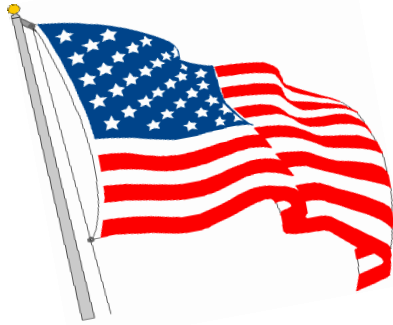

DeBary Hall’s Education Coordinator will visit classrooms to give a 45-minute tour of the history of DeBary Hall. The Coordinator will bring artifacts and exhibits from DeBary Hall and discuss living and vacationing in Central Florida in the 19th Century. The charge is \$35 per class. Call (386) 668-3840 to arrange this tour to visit your classroom.

ARCHITECTURAL TOURS

Architectural tours introduce visitors to the architectural qualities and amenities of DeBary Hall, an 1871 Italianate hunting lodge. Youth groups can learn architectural terms and features through a bingo scavenger hunt. These 1-hour tours are available Tuesday through Saturday. The charge is \$5 for adults and \$3 for youths and seniors.

ECOLOGICAL TOURS

Ecological tours focus on animals and plants around DeBary Hall and explain how the landscape changed through time. Youth groups can learn about the site by completing a geo-cache activity. These 1-hour tours are available Tuesday through Saturday. The charge is \$6 for adults, \$5 for seniors, and \$3 for youths.

VIRTUAL TOUR OF ST. JOHNS RIVER

The basic school and youth group tour starts with a virtual ride up the St. Johns River, followed by a tour of DeBary Hall. Groups learn about vacationing in early Florida, gizmos and gadgets, and the de Bary family. These 1-hour tours are available Tuesday through Saturday for \$3 for youths and \$5 for chaperones.

TEA-TASTING TOURS

Sip tea with friends, try your hand at geo-caching, or learn about vacationing in 19th Century Florida. With tea-tasting tours, groups can take a guided tour of DeBary Hall, taste tea, and learn about Victorian tea traditions. The 2-hour tours cost \$12 a person and are available Fridays and Saturdays.

BECOME AN ECHO RANGER!

Join the **ECHO Ranger program** by calling DeBary Hall and speaking with Amber or Lynn at (386) 668-3840. Call Tuesdays through Saturdays between 8 AM and 5 PM.

Ranger candidates receive a personalized **ECHO Ranger** badge and lanyard and will participate in outdoor and indoor activities at many sites such as Lake Woodruff National Wildlife Refuge, DeLand Naval Air Station Museum, Pioneer Settlement at Barberville, and Ponce Inlet Lighthouse. Candidates will receive a Ranger stamp when they complete the activities at a site. Activities last between 1 to 3 hours mostly on weekends. A minimum of 8 stamps must be received to become an official **ECHO Ranger**.

The fee is \$15 for the 10-month program, weekends from September to June, which include the Ranger candidate and one adult. Reservations must be made 1 to 2 weeks in advance to visit each site. Each successful candidate will be given a special T-shirt, cookout and graduation celebration, where they will be promoted from candidate to official ECHO Ranger. This is an excellent opportunity to learn hands-on experience in Heritage, Ecology, Culture, and the Outdoors. This is also a program for Scout troops.

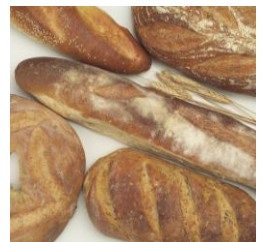

► FLORIDA LAWS ON CONSUMER FIREWORKS

■ **SPECIFICALLY PROHIBITED:** Firecrackers, torpedoes, skyrockets, roman candles, and daygo bombs.

• Specifically permitted: Devices that emit a shower of sparks upon burning, do not contain any explosive compounds, do not detonate or explode, are hand-held or ground-based, **cannot propel themselves through the air**, and that contain no more than 100 grams of the chemical compound that produces sparks upon burning. Snakes, small smoke devices, trick noisemakers and certain other novelties are also allowed.

According to the State Fire Marshals Office, anyone using fireworks must have a permit from their local government or for certain agricultural purposes be exempted by law. It is illegal in Florida to use fireworks, which include: shells and mortars, multiple tube devices, Roman candles, rockets and firecrackers, when such use is not in strict compliance with Chapter 791.012, Florida Statutes. Floridians should not sign "waivers" in order to purchase fireworks. Signing a waiver will not clear you of responsibility should you be caught illegally using fireworks, which is a first-degree misdemeanor punishable by up to one year in jail and a \$1,000 fine.
