## ADOPT - A - PLANTER

The City's Streetscape Advisory Committee invites DeBary residents and businesses to participate in the Adopt-A-Planter program. Along US Highway 17/92, from Highbanks to Plantation Road, the City has installed 41 terra-cotta colored reinforced concrete planters. The planters are 5' diameter and 36" high outside dimensions. Planter inside dimensions are 1'9" radius x 31" high with approximately 25 cubic feet of inside space. Each planter has a self-contained irrigation system. Adopting a planter includes installing and maintaining plants so as to present an excellent appearance. If you, your business, or your organization would like to adopt a planter, please stop by City Hall to register with the City Clerk.

## DeBary's Historical Calendar 2007

The City's Historic Preservation Advisory Board is planning to publish a 2007 City Calendar with pictures reflecting the history of the DeBary area. In keeping with the historical nature of the Calendar, it will be published in black and white.

Residents are encouraged to contribute pictures, which they feel may be appropriate for inclusion in the Calendar, to Anita Gonzalez at Florence K. Little Town Hall. Pictures should depict an historical event, a view, or person(s) relating to the history of DeBary. No more than two (2) entries from each family will be accepted. Pictures should be labeled on the back, along with the contestant's name and address. Copies of your originals may be submitted rather than the originals.

The Board will judge which pictures will be included in the Calendar. Any pictures included will become the property of the Board and will not be returned to the owner. The Calendar will be named DeBary Historic Preservation Advisory Board Calendar 2007.

The deadline for all entries is June 30, 2006. Upon publication, the Calendar will be available free of charge at DeBary City Hall. Announcement of the availability of the Calendar will be made in the City's Newsletter and on the City's website.

### Disposal of Insulin Needles
