The DRC members reviewed the comments. Discussion ensued regarding the application and submittal.

- 1. David Hamstra will contact Scott Mays to determine what type of barrier the City wants for the cycle tract.
- 2. Barrier in between the railroad tracks and the development on Shell Road is a must.
- 3. ADA curbs/breaks need to be raised to 6 inch curbs with spots flush for ADA on Main Street.
- 4. Add Votran bus stops on 17-92 at tract A & tract C. Votran needs to be contacted about this issue. They will also need loading platforms for the bus.
- 5. Parking for bicycles and motorcycles on street parking spots needed.
- 6. Request a letter from Scott Mays for capacity for infrastructure capacity.
- 7. 6-foot-wide center lane needs to be added to the plans to add concrete ribbon curb down the middle.
- 8. Ground floor must be retail only no housing.
- 9. Liner in the pond needed to keep it wet.
- 10. Retention pond on the east and west banks need retainer walls.

Richard Villasenor motioned and put forth the motion for approval and Michael Parker seconded this motion contingent on addressing outstanding comments and pending revisions.
