- 1. The metal decking does not meet the standards. Real life examples needed to explore further.
- 2. Single lane driveways are 12 feet because of the pre-fab building. The minimum is 14 feet in the City ordinances.

Revisions will need to be addressed prior to the next DRC meeting; addressing outstanding comments from engineering and the arborist.

213 Admiral Lane

The DRC members reviewed the comments. Discussion ensued regarding the application and submittal.

- 1. Clarification on the dimensions of the existing structures on the lot was given;
- 2. Applicant stated that this roof was on the previously submitted site plans for the building permits for the other structures that were approved, and that this created the hardship, and the unique situation; and
- 3. It was noted that the planners who reviewed the original plan are no longer with the City.
