7 Seminole Drive Future Land Use Map Amendment Project # 22-02-CPA-7 Seminole

Rivington, Phase 3 Preliminary Plat & Construction Plat

Brent Lenzen of Kimley-Horn & Associates, Inc. came forward to speak on behalf of the applicant, Dean Barberree. Mr. Lenzen responded to various comments from Planning & Zoning. He stated the environmental components of this project have been addressed.

Richard Villasenor stated there is a major storm pipe running between two lots north of Terrapin Drive. He asked if there is any possibility the new sanitary sewer manhole can be extended further out the paved area to connect the force main. Mr. Lenzen stated he would reach out to Volusia County Utilities

Richard Villasenor made a motion to approve the preliminary plat and construction plan, contingent on addressing outstanding comments, seconded by Michael Parker. The motion passed by a 4-0 vote.
