STORMWATER MAINTENANCE – LEVEL II

JOB SUMMARY:

Under direct supervision of a Crew Chief, employees in this position perform semi-skilled work, which is performed alone or as part of a crew, involving stormwater system inspections, maintenance, and repairs. Performs and may lead duties related to manual labor functions for city streets, stormwater and ROW areas.

JOB DESCRIPTION

The following duties are normal for this position. The omission of specific statements of the duties does not exclude them from the classification if the work is similar, related, or a logical assignment for this classification. Other duties may be required and assigned.

DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Participates and may lead directly in all manual labor functions such as mowing, trimming, cutting brush, trash removal, groundskeeping, etc.
- Operates and may lead operation of equipment in performance of duties such as mowers, trimmers, blowers, tree trimmers, trucks, lifting equipment, chain saws, etc.
- Assists or may lead in moving of supplies, materials and equipment to all work areas.
- Assists with the inspection of Stormwater Best Management Practices.
- Assists with the compliance and enforcement of the Stormwater Management Program and stormwater ordinances.
- Assists with the investigation to detect and eliminate illicit discharge and connections.
- Completes maintenance time sheets, logs and records as required.
- May inform the general public in the usage of public areas.
- Performs duties related to minor repairs of public streets patching, grinding, slab replacement, concrete forming, removal of concrete, asphalt repairs, etc.
- Maintains and assists in safety of self and other crew members by observation of traffic and vehicular movement.



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- Maintains, inspects and installs stormwater systems and equipment as directed in order to assure proper and adequate drainage for streets and ROW areas.
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- Performs stormwater system inspections and repairs, including: storm drain structures, piping, and ditches: install drainage pipes, repair storm drains, catch basins, and pipes, digging and backfill trenches; and retrofitting catch basin lids.
- Operates/utilizes a variety of equipment or tool associated with activities, may include truck, backhoe, front loader, excavator, hand tools, and cement.
- Attends all required training, safety and regulatory workshops as required by management and current events/situations.
- Employees working at this level may be requested to lead crews as required by extenuating circumstances by management.
- Performs other related duties and functions as assigned.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

High school graduate or GED with one (1) to two (2) years of directly related experience in general labor using appropriate tools and/or equipment.

CERTIFICATES, LICENSES & REGISTRATIONS:

Possession of and ability to maintain a valid State of Florida Driver's License is required. Attendance at workshops/seminars related to streets and ROW duties will be required for all employees at this level. Employees at this level will be required to act as lead positions as needed. Certification in applicable daily duty may qualify employees for this level as determined and approved by management in Public Works.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS & ABILITIES:

Communication Skills: Ability to read and interpret documents such as safety rules, operating and maintenance instructions, and procedure manuals. Ability to write routine reports and correspondence. Ability to speak effectively before groups of customers or employees of organization.



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Reasoning Ability: Ability to solve practical problems and deal with a variety of concrete variables in situations where only limited standardization exists. In decision making, some choices are known while others may need to be identified. Some reliance on precedent. Ability to interpret a variety of complex instructions furnished in written, oral, diagram, or schedule form.

WORK ENVIRONMENT/ADA:

Physical Ability: The physical demands and work environment here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to use hands to finger, handle, or feel objects, tools, or controls and talks or hears. The employee frequently is required to stand, walk, and reach with hands and arms. The employee is occasionally required to sit; climb or balance; and stoop, kneel, crouch, or crawl.

The employee must lift and/or move up to 25 pounds, frequently lift and/or move up to 50 pounds, occasionally lift and/or move 100 pounds. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision, color vision, peripheral vision, depth perception, and the ability to adjust focus.

Environmental Factors: While performing the duties of this job, the employee regularly works in outside weather conditions and is regularly exposed to extreme cold and extreme heat. The employee is occasionally exposed to fumes or airborne particles, toxic or caustic chemicals, risk of electrical shock, and vibration.
